Colon Cancer Screening

Service	How Often Covered	Date Done	Date Due
Barium Enema	Every 48 months Every 24 months if high risk		
Colonoscopy	Every 120 months Every 48 months after a flexible sigmoidoscopy Every 24 months if high risk		
Fecal Occult Blood Test	Annually		
Flexible Sigmoidoscopy	Every 48 months Every 120 months after a screening colonoscopy		
Stool DNA Test	Every 3 years <i>Must meet all criteria:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aged 50- to 85-years-old• No blood in the stool• No personal history for colon polyps, Crohn’s disease, or ulcerative colitis• No family history for colon polyps or cancer		

Other Cancer Screening

Service	How Often Covered and For Whom	Date Done	Date Due
Breast Cancer: Mammogram	Women 35–39 years old: One baseline mammogram -OR- Women 40+ years old: Every 12 months		
Cervical Cancer: Pap Smear	Every 24 months for all women -OR- Every 5 years for women 30 to 65 years old if done with HPV testing -OR- Every 12 months for women “at risk”: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Abnormal Pap test within last 36 months Childbearing age High risk for cervical or vaginal cancer 		
Lung Cancer: Low-Dose CT Scan of the Lungs	Annually <i>Must meet all criteria:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ages 55- to 77-years-old Current smoker -OR- former smoker who quit within the past 15 years Smoked at least 1 pack per day for 30 years 		
Prostate Cancer: Rectal Exam	Annually		
Prostate Cancer: PSA Test	Annually
