Alcohol Abuse Screening	Annually		
Blood Pressure Check	Annually		
Bone Density Study	<ul> <li>Every 24 months for people with one or more of the following:</li> <li>Estrogen deficiency/menopause</li> <li>Osteoporosis on drug therapy</li> <li>Prednisone or steroid drug use</li> <li>Primary hyperparathyroidism</li> <li>X-rays suggestive for osteopenia, osteoporosis or vertebral fracture</li> </ul>		
Cholesterol and Lipid Screening	Once every 5 years		
Depression Screening	Annually		
Obesity Behavioral Counseling	<ul> <li>For people with BMI &gt; 30</li> <li>Once per week for one month</li> <li>Once every other week for 5 months</li> <li>Once monthly for 6 months if you lost 6.6 lbs in the first six months</li> </ul>		
Tobacco Use Counseling	8 counseling sessions per year For people who currently smoke
